Three UOG Students Receive Camacho Foundation Scholarships

The Felix M. and Governor Carlos G. Camacho Scholarship Foundation has awarded \$2,000 scholarships to three outstanding undergraduate students from the University of Guam for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Freshman Mia Marchessault, sophomore Yoonji Seo, and junior Brian Teodosio were recognized at a special awards ceremony on November 9 for their academic achievements and commitment to their studies. Marchessault and Teodosio are pursuing degrees in business administration, while Seo is majoring in accounting.
